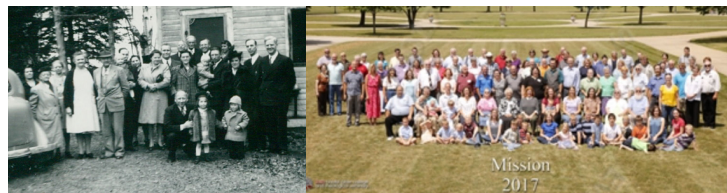


### Berean Independent Baptist Church in Fort Ashby, WV

As a mission's agency, Continental Baptist Missions celebrated its 75th anniversary this year. CBM started as Hiawatha Land Independent Baptist Missions in May of 1942 with six missionary families. These missionaries had a burden to bring the gospel to the remote logging and mining camps in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. CBM now has missionaries serving across the continental United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico. In Genesis, Jacob crossed the Jordan the first time with only his staff. When he crossed again, he did so with two companies of family, servants, and animals. Just as God was faithful to Jacob, God has been faithful to CBM and its desires to provide support services for planting, revitalizing and building biblically sound and spiritually healthy Baptist churches in North America. What are some things you are thankful for?

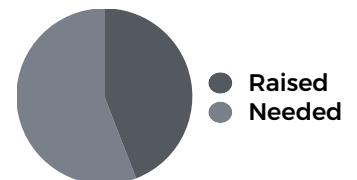
- Amanda (13) "A warm house and fuzzy blankets."
