Amanda (10) - "Camp, VBS, and my birthday."

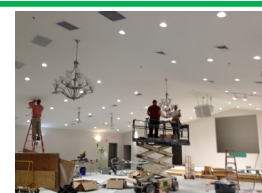
Luke (9) - "Camp."
