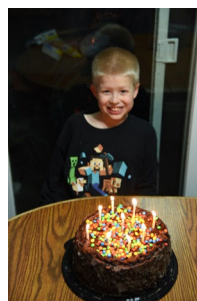
the story over and over to friends and family who have shared in her amazement and joy. It was a good reminder of how much more the angels in Heaven rejoice when a lost sinner repents.
