We also attended the Minnesota Baptist Association Conference. We praise God for all of you and the support and encouragement you provide through Him.

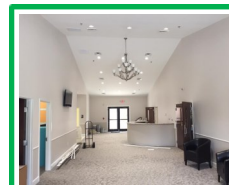
