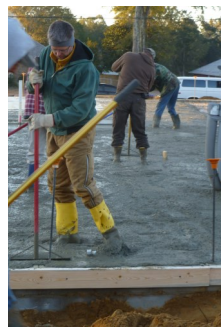
What did you enjoy about being on the build site in Florida?
