Amanda (10) - "Probably staying at people's houses"

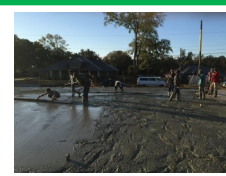
Luke (9) - "Riding and driving the golf cart"
